At each event there will be

Short, medium and long courses (2-7km) where controls are visited in a specific order.

Scatter orienteering course where participants choose the controls to be visited.

Start at any time between 6 and 7 p.m.

All courses are available to runner and walkers and involve simple map reading techniques similar to reading a street map.

Helpers on hand to assist newcomers.

Compasses are not required.

We recommend that children under 14 are accompanied by an adult.

Arrive at the start location between the designated times with running gear or similar. You may wish to bring a towel, change of clothes and drinks for warm evenings. Bring a picnic. Run or walk – then relax.

If the forecast temperature is over 35°, courses will still be available but will be non-competitive.

Look for these red and white orienteering signs in the vicinity of the locations given for each event.
