

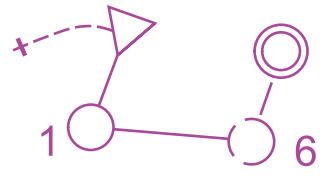

	Passable at two levels: Over bridge upper level / brown stripe, A - A Triangle line shows access to lower level / white stripe, under bridge B - B
	Passable at two levels: Using stairs to access upper level / brown stripe Triangle line shows access to lower level / white stripe
	Canopy between buildings Passable under canopy
	Step or edge of paved areas
	A paved area with scattered trees
	Permitted access along a Track through an area that shall not be entered (Olive green)
	Small depression and contour depressions
	Small knolls and contour hills
	Track junctions: indistinct and distinct
