SmokeFree Policy

The Orienteering Association of South Australia Inc (OASA) acknowledges that smoking is detrimental to the development and maintenance of good health both for individuals and for the community. As an organisation that seeks to enhance health, *OASA* will model SmokeFree behaviours to its constituents.

OASA will:

- ensure that all enclosed public places are SmokeFree in accordance with SA Government legislation;
- ensure that all eating areas are SmokeFree;
- ensure that most and preferably 100% of outdoor spectator areas under *OASA*'s control are SmokeFree;
- ensure that all social functions (including junior events, competitions, dinners, fundraising events and meetings) are SmokeFree;
- ensure that coaches, trainers, volunteers and officials refrain from smoking while acting in an official capacity;
- ensure that members of the Southern Arrows refrain from smoking while in uniform;
- ensure that SmokeFree behaviour is incorporated into the code of behaviour for coaches, administrators and participants;
- ensure that cigarettes are not sold (including from vending machines) in venues under *OASA*'s control.

Where applicable orienteering coaches and officials:

- involved in "SmokeFree" school clinics will attend an inservice and then promote "SmokeFree" behaviour during these clinics;
- will ensure that training sessions include discussions of the effects of smoking on performance.

OASA will promote the reasons for these behaviours to its constituents through newsletters, signage, etc., noting that *OASA* is a health promoting organisation.
