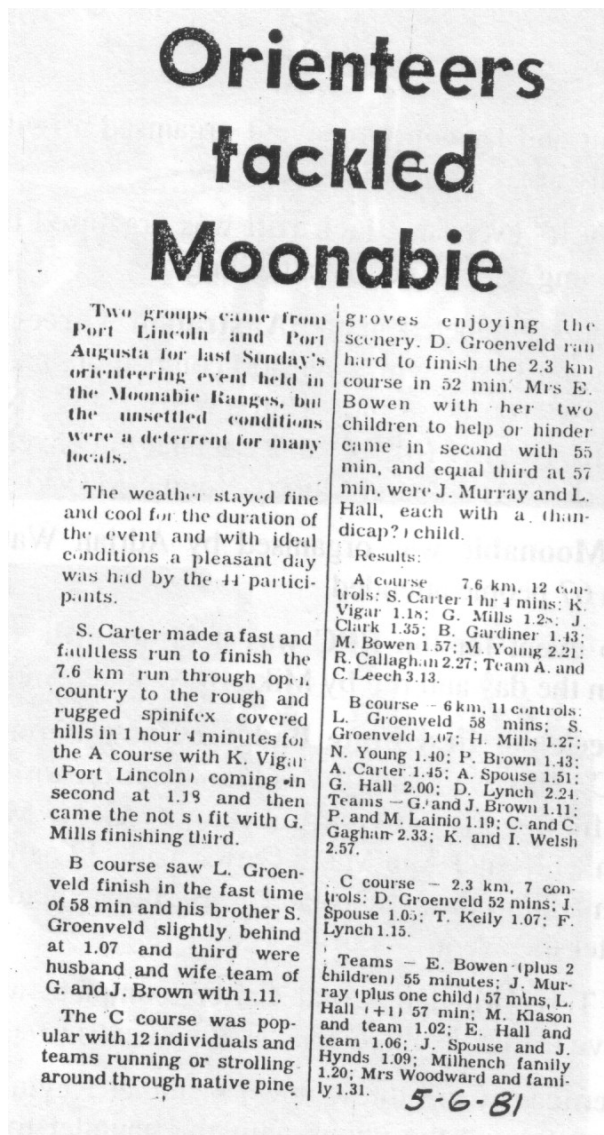


SALTBUSH MEMORIES FROM 1981
