Typical TJ efficiency had the results posted on the OASA website that very evening.

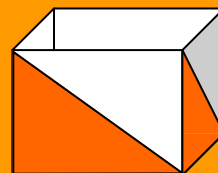
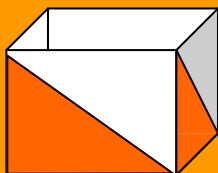


NEXT TJ EVENT

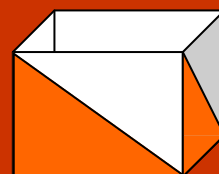
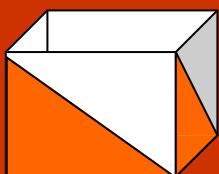
