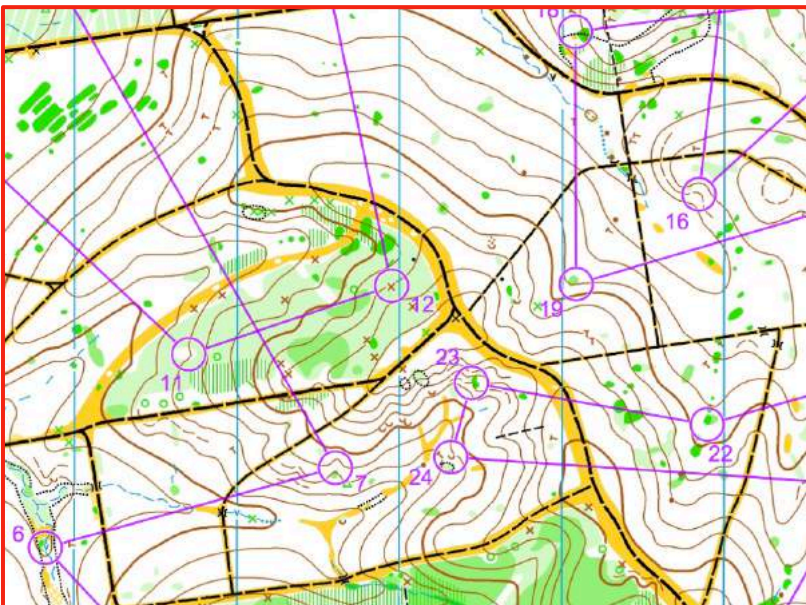


## TJ Kuitpo Airstrip OY event

# CLUB RELAYS

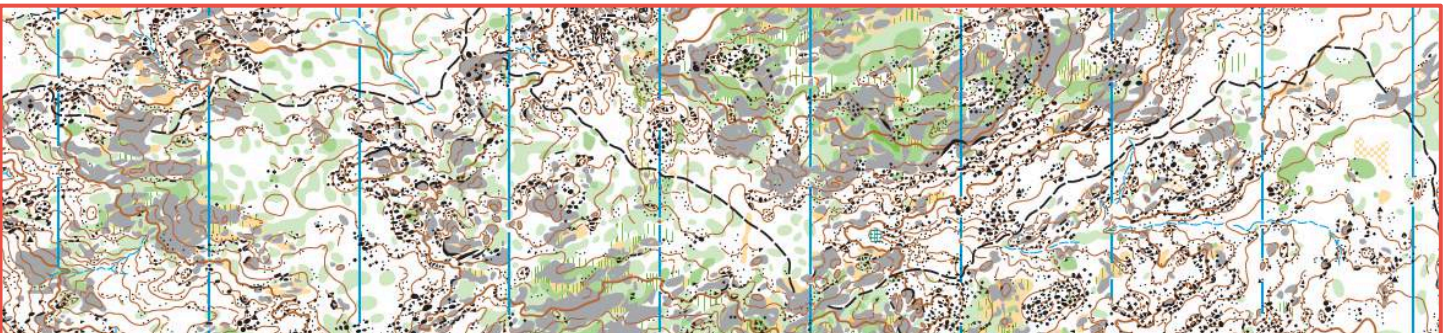
