

On the day it became more of a group effort, not only for our club but for other members of Orienteering SA which was helped by fine weather and ‘many hands made light work’. There were 165 entrants from twenty-one schools but it was commented that because of the quality of the organising, the event would have proceeded just as well with double that number.


Two Wallaringans took part in the actual competition and both obtained first place in their age groups. Congratulations to Scarlett and Jessica.
